

Occupational Certificate Child and Youth Care Worker

This Qualification is an entry-level qualification for those who want to enter the field of Child & Youth Care Work (C&YCW) as a potential career. It builds on practical experience and community-based learning, and equips people for their role as a child and youth care worker. As such the Qualification will also be valuable for those who may have been practising within the field/scope, but without formal recognition. Most especially, this Qualification will be useful for:

Child and youth care workers. Persons who work in related fields such as social workers, pastoral counsellors, where knowledge and skill of C&YCW is an advantage.



Occupational Certificate Social Auxiliary Worker

The purpose of the qualification is to equip qualifying learners with the following:

- Knowledge and understanding of the South African context within which social services function and are delivered.
- Understanding of social development in terms of the needs, policies, and the role of the Social Auxiliary Worker.
- Basic knowledge of human behavior, relationship systems and social issues and the ability to address social needs using appropriate Social Auxiliary Work methods and techniques.
- The skills to work as a team member and as a provider of support services to the Social Work team

This qualification will prepare learners to render basic counselling and support services to individuals and families with socio-economic challenges.

Facilitate non-therapeutic (educational and support groups) groups as well as participatory development in communities to address their common socio-economic needs, to promote social justice and to collect and collate data to inform social services intervention



Credits: 143 credits registered with Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (SAQA).

Duration: This is a 2-year qualification that depends on the specific circumstances of the student. With this qualification.

The program contains:

- 1. 30 credits of Knowledge modules (300 hours theoretical),
- 2. 48 credits practical (480 hours practical) and
- 3. 65 credits workplace (650 hours workplace experience).

The theoretical modules are presented in a weekly class in person or by Zoom. A Facilitator is assigned to you who will guide you through the theoretical, practical and workplace.

There are three theoretical modules, four practical and four workplace modules that must be completed before final exams.
